



TOWNSHIP 17 NORTH, RANGE 77 WEST, OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the west boundary, and a portion of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of sections 18 and 20, T. 17 N., R. 77 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

The lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved October 9, 1884.


