From this point, an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., as described in the field notes of the 1966 dependent resurvey, bears N. 0° 34' E., 2.33 chs. dist. I mark the brass cap AM in large letters, and efface the mks. on the 1966 bearing tree.

SURVEY INFORMATION AND CERTIFICATE

This plat represents the entire record of the corrective dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence.

The position of the N. 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 17 and 18, was purported as not conforming to the official record by letter dated October 20, 1995 from James D. Walker, NJS Engineering, Spearfish, South Dakota. A field investigation substantiated the purported findings. A corrective dependent resurvey is described in detail herein.

This survey was executed in accordance with the specifications set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1973, and the Special Instructions dated October 31, 1995, for Group No. 613, and assignment instructions dated November 3, 1995.

Louis F. Stahle surveyed the subdivisional lines in 1881. Clifford A. Robinson dependently resurveyed a portion of the subdivisional lines in 1965-66.

The lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved October 4, 1882.

Survey executed by Lynn A. Forbes, Cadastral Surveyor, beginning November 27, 1995 and completed November 27, 1995.

The direction of the lines refer to the true meridian as determined by the dependent resurvey plat of 1965-66 and carried forward by sustained angulation. Measurements were made using a WILD theodolite, Model T-1000, a WILD electronic distance meter, Model DI-2000 and by chaining methods. The instruments were maintained in proper adjustment at all times.

The geographic position (NAD 27) of the 1/4 corner of sections 17 and 18, as scaled from U.S. Geological Survey Quadrangle Map "THE ROCKS, WYOMING", 1984 is as follows:

Latitude: 44°29'34"N. Longitude: 104°34'43"W.

Field assistants were James D. Clafin Cadastral Surveyor, and Ryan R. Lorenzen, Surveying Technician.

The area embraced by this survey is situated approximately 30 miles northwest of Sundance Wyoming. Access is provided by U.S. Highway 14, county roads and trails throught the area. Vegetation consists of pine and oak forests.

I, Lynn A. Forbes, Cadastral Surveyor, certify that the corrective dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines was executed by me and under my direction as described above and as shown on this plat.

Excepting as new or modified vacant subdivisions are shown hereon, the lottings are as shown on the plat approved October 4, 1882.


