


TOWNSHIP 32 NORTH, RANGE 100 WEST, OF THE 6TH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the east boundary and a portion of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original location, according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of section 25, T. 32 N., R. 100 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lotting and areas are as shown on the plats approved February 21, 1885 and July 12, 1966.
