


TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 86 WEST, OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

A portion of the east boundary was dependently resurveyed during the dependent resurvey, T. 29 N., R. 85 W., executed concurrently under this same group.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of section 12, T. 29 N., R. 86 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.


