







This Supplemental Plat No. 4, Resurvey of Township 54 North, Range No. 99 West, 6th PM, plat approved December 13, 1905 is prepared in accordance with directions given in Commissioner's Letter "E" dated Sept. 28, 1926 for the purpose of showing certain LOTS, created in the township resurvey, completely divided into aliquot subdivisions, nominally equivalent to the original legal subdivisions embraced therein. These lots were originally created to define certain lands segregated to the State of Wyoming under the Act of August 18, 1894 (Corey Act) which have been relinquished to the United States; and are now replatted as public lands under their true areas. The lots subdivided hereon are: Lots 47, 46, 45, 44, 43, 41, 40, and 78. Except for Lot 43, the plan of subdivision shown continues the partial subdivision of said LOTS shown on Supplemental Plats of this and adjoining townships. The purpose of this plat is to accommodate the preparation of Farm Unit Plats, Shoshone Project, Bureau of Reclamation; and is hereby approved.






