

# TOWNSHIP 14 NORTH, RANGE 106 WEST, OF THE 6th PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

## DEPENDENT RESURVEY AND SUBDIVISION OF SECTION 10

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes. This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of Section 10, T. 14 N., R. 106 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

The lottings and areas are as shown on the plats approved November 18, 1902, and February 15, 1927.


