



TOWNSHIP 20 NORTH, RANGE 109 WEST, OF THE 6th PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of section 8, T. 20 N., R. 109 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.  
The lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved March 7, 1916.
