




# TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 3 EAST, OF THE WIND RIVER MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of portions of the south and west boundaries and subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of section 31, T. 2 N., R. 3 E., Wind River Meridian, Wyoming.

The lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved December 4, 1891.
