



TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 1 EAST, OF THE WIND RIVER MERIDIAN, WYOMING.



A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the Wind River Meridian, south boundary, subdivisional lines, and adjusted meanders of the Wind River, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the survey of the subdivision of certain sections, and the metes and bounds survey of Parcel A, section 29, T. 3 N., R. 1 E., Wind River Meridian, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved April 15, 1891.
