


TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 4 WEST, OF THE WIND RIVER MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY, SUBDIVISION OF SECTION, AND METES AND BOUNDS SURVEY

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the survey of the subdivision of section 15, and the metes and bounds survey of Parcel A, section 15, T. 4 N., R. 4 W., Wind River Meridian, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved January 14, 1899.
