



TOWNSHIP 5 NORTH, RANGE 6 WEST, OF THE WIND RIVER MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY, SUBDIVISION OF SECTION 3, METES AND BOUNDS SURVEY




ENLARGED DIAGRAM

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the west boundary of the Wind River Indian Reservation, the north boundary, subdivisional lines, and adjusted meanders of the right bank of the Wind River, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, the survey of the subdivision of section 3, and the metes and bounds survey of Parcels A and B, section 3, T. 5 N., R. 6 W., Wind River Meridian, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved January 14, 1899.
