

Notice is hereby given to whom it may concern that W. E. Smith, William Wilkison and Thomas C. Hauer do declare their intention to apply for a Patent to our Mine the "Michigan Lode" situate in the Rawhide Buttes Mining District, Laramie County, Wyoming Territory and of record in Book 6 Page 37 in the Records - Office of Rawhide Buttes Mining District in the City of Cheyenne Wyoming Territory We claim by right of Discovery and location (fifteen hundred linear feet) along the vein upon which our claim is located.

From this point our Discovery Shaft in a course S. 84° 50' E we claim 600 feet in a course N. 84° 50' W. We claim three hundred feet in a course N. 5° 10' E. We claim (750 feet) seven hundred and fifty feet and in a course S. 5° 10' W. We claim seven hundred and fifty feet. The nearest known location is the Mary Jane to the Northward.
