


TOWNSHIP 43 NORTH, RANGE 67 WEST, OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY



A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of the south boundary, and a portion of the east boundary designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, T. 43 N., R. 67 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

The lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved October 16, 1882.
