


TOWNSHIP 44 NORTH, RANGE 63 WEST, OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY AND SUBDIVISION OF SECTION 12



A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

The east boundary was dependently resurveyed by Carl W. Sumpter and Thomas H. Effinger during the resurvey of T. 44 N., R. 62 W., executed concurrently under this same group.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines, and the subdivision of section 12, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, T. 44 N., R. 63 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

The lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved August 3, 1882.
