 - BLM has the ability to clarify and react, in a timely manner, to changes in the biological environment.
 - Ensure public consultation

CLARIFICATIONS

- ▣ Implementation/use Of Adaptive Management Does Not Require Waiting For Annual Planning Meeting

Process contained in Memorandum dated October 20, 2010

Seven Steps

1. Memorandum to Field Manager
2. Field Manager Convenes Review Team (PAPO, BLM, and other agency staff specialists)
3. Review Team Deliberations
 - Determine if the proposal has merit
 - Determine immediacy of the need for change
 - Determine NEPA compliance
4. Provide public and industry review
 - 14 days minimum (PAWG, Public, Industry)
5. Field Manager and Review Team consideration of public/industry review comments
6. Preparation of final recommendation memo by Review Team
7. Documentation of the Record/Disclosure of decision
