NOTICE OF COMPETITIVE LEASE SALE

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, April 6, 1999, the Bureau of Land Management, Wyoming State Office, will offer for competitive sale, pursuant to 43 CFR Part 3120 and procedures herein, certain Federal lands for oil and gas leasing.

LOCATION: The sale will be held in the Convention Center, Holiday Inn, 204 West Fox Farm Road (I-80 and US-85), Cheyenne, Wyoming. You must be present to bid. A block of rooms at a special rate of \$46.00 per room has been reserved for sale participants at the Holiday Inn. You may call the Holiday Inn at (307) 638-4466, extension 152, for further information or reservations. When making room reservations, please identify yourself as attending the BLM LAND SALE .

TIME: The competitive oral auction will commence at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, April 6, 1999, and shall run for one day until all parcels are offered. The Receiving Room will be open to the public at 7:00 a.m. to allow each interested bidder time to register and obtain a bidder number.

REGISTRATION AND BIDDER NUMBERS: Bidders must have a number in order to bid. Registration of bidders in order to obtain a bidder number will be required. Registration of bidders will be conducted in the Receiving Room.

LANDS OFFERED: The lands to be offered are described herein. Parcels will be offered for oral bid in the order shown in this Notice of Competitive Lease Sale. Parcels are listed in Range-Township order by state and land type.

TERMS OF LEASE: Leases awarded as a result of this oral auction will be for a primary term of 10 years, and for so long thereafter as there is production in paying quantities. The royalty will be a flat rate of 12-1/2 percent of the value or the amount of production removed or sold from the lease. Other terms of the lease are specified on the lease form.

OTHER CONDITIONS: Surface use stipulations are identified in this Notice of Competitive Lease Sale. Stipulations shall become part of the lease and shall supersede any inconsistent provisions of the lease form. General surface use requirements are contained in law and regulation. A map with Bureau of Land Management (BLM) field office boundaries and a sheet with addresses and telephone numbers are included in this Notice; please contact the appropriate office for questions on the BLM stipulations. Questions related to the Bureau of Reclamation parcels should be addressed to the Bureau of Reclamation, Great Plains Region, P.O. Box 36900, Billings, Montana 59107-6900 (telephone number 406-247-7716). See the back of this Notice for the text of the Bureau of Reclamation stipulations.

MINIMUM BID: The minimum acceptable bonus bid will be the lump sum equivalent of \$2 per acre or fraction thereof. All bids received shall be deemed submitted for an entire parcel.

METHOD OF BIDDING: All bids shall be made orally and shall be based on a per-acre amount to cover the entire acreage in a parcel.

FRACTIONAL INTERESTS: If the United States holds less than 100 percent of the oil and gas rights, as specified in this Notice, any lease issued will be only for the percentage or fractions indicated; however, bonus bids and rentals for such parcels shall be based on the gross acreage in the parcel, not the net U.S. interest. Chargeable acreage and production royalty are, in contrast, calculated on the net U.S. interest.

RIGHT TO WITHDRAW PARCELS FROM SALE: The Bureau of Land Management reserves the right to withdraw any or all of the parcels at any time prior to sale.

DETERMINATION OF WINNING BID: A winning bid will be the highest oral bid equal to or exceeding the minimum bid of \$2 per acre. The decision of the auctioneer shall be final.

PAYMENT OF MINIMUM BONUS BID, RENTAL, AND ADMINISTRATIVE FEE: A bid shall not be withdrawn and shall constitute a legally binding commitment to execute the lease bid form and accept a lease, including the obligation to pay the bonus bid, first year's rental, and administrative fee. There

have been cases in past oral auctions where the minimum deposit due from the high bidder on the day of the auction was not paid, or was paid by a check drawn on an account with insufficient funds. The Bureau of Land Management will be closely monitoring situations of this nature to determine whether further measures should be initiated to protect the integrity of the system. Please be advised that Department of the Treasury rules require that checks received on the day of the sale be deposited immediately following the sale.

Winning bidders shall be required to make a minimum payment at the auction, on the day of the oral auction, of: (1) the minimum bonus bid of \$2 per acre or fraction thereof; (2) the total amount of the first year's annual rental at a rate of \$1.50 per acre or fraction thereof; and (3) an administrative fee of \$75 per parcel. Failure to pay this minimum deposit may result in assessment of civil penalties pursuant to the Federal Oil and Gas Royalty Management Act. The total payment of all monies due may be made at this time.

FORM OF PAYMENT: Payment shall be made by personal check, certified check, or money order (such forms of payment must be made payable to the DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR - BLM), or by credit card (VISA or MasterCard accepted only). If payment will be made by credit card, bidders should contact their bank prior to the sale to inform them that a substantial charge may be made against that account. This will alleviate any authorization problems on the day of the sale. Payment by cash shall NOT be allowed.

REMAINING PAYMENTS: Any remaining payment beyond the minimum required on the day of sale shall be tendered to the Wyoming State Office, 5353 Yellowstone Road, Box 1828, Cheyenne, WY 82003, by 4:00 p.m. on:
Tuesday, April 20, 1999

A failure to remit the remaining monies due by the time specified shall result in forfeiture of the right to issuance of the lease and of all previously tendered fees for the lease. Any entity who forfeits the right of issuance of a lease (failure to submit the remaining monies due) on three occasions is prohibited from bidding at any future sale in this State.

BID FORM REQUIRED--AVAILABILITY: Pursuant to 43 CFR 3120.5-3, successful high bidders will be required to submit with the required payments for each parcel, on the day of the oral auction, a properly signed competitive lease bid form (Form 3000-2, June 1988 or later edition). Form 3000-2 is a legally binding offer to accept a lease pursuant to the terms and conditions specified herein and on the standard lease form (Form 3100-11, June 1988 or later edition) and may be obtained and executed by the prospective lessee prior to the oral auction. If the lease bid form is completed before the oral auction, it cannot be modified; however, portions of the form may be left blank to be completed by the

bidder at the auction. If the form is not executed before the auction, the prospective lessee must complete and sign the form at the auction when payment is made. Form 3000-2, when completed, certifies compliance with lessee qualifications (43 CFR 3102.5-2) and also certifies compliance with 18 USC 1860, which prohibits unlawful combination of or intimidation of bidders and certifies that the bid was arrived at independently without unlawful collusion.

AWARD OF LEASES: Leases will be awarded to the highest qualified bidder after payment of all monies due and execution of all required lease documents. The lease shall issue upon signing of the lease form by an authorized officer of the Bureau of Land Management. The effective date of the lease shall be the first day of the month following signature of the lease form by the authorized officer, unless a specific written request is made that the effective date be the first of the month in which the lease is signed by the authorized officer.

OTHER CONDITIONS OF SALE: The authorized officer shall at the time of sale make any rule regarding sale procedures which in his or her opinion is necessary for the proper conduct of the sale.

UNSOLD PARCELS: Parcels contained in this Notice of Competitive Lease Sale for which no bids are received at the oral auction and no noncompetitive presale offers are pending, and which have not been withdrawn from the sale by BLM, shall be available for regular noncompetitive lease offer in accordance with 43 CFR Subpart 3110 for a two-year period. The two-year period shall commence at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, April 7, 1999. All noncompetitive offers received on that first business day following the auction will be considered simultaneously filed. Offers received thereafter shall receive priority as of the date and time of filing as specified at 43 CFR 1821.2-3(a).

PENDING NONCOMPETITIVE PRESALE OFFERS: A presale noncompetitive offer filed in accordance with 43 CFR 3110.1(a) for a parcel offered at the sale, and for which no bid was received, has first priority over an offer filed after the sale. Parties are cautioned that any lands in a parcel not sold at the auction which are subject to a pending noncompetitive presale offer may not be available for further noncompetitive filings. Those lands will be issued to the party who submitted the presale offer, all else being regular. However, if it is announced at the beginning of the sale that the presale offer has been withdrawn, noncompetitive filings will be accepted after the sale for that parcel. Parcels with pending noncompetitive presale offers are identified in this Notice of Competitive Lease Sale by the notation "Pending Offer (number)" indicated after the parcel description. Parcels WY-9904-067 and WY-9904-073 have pending noncompetitive offers.

DROP BOX: For the convenience of those attending the sale, a drop box will be available at the sale site on the sale date (Tuesday, April 6, 1999) to receive noncompetitive offers; however, any offer received in that manner and at that time will be considered to have been filed at the Wyoming State Office as of 9:00 a.m., Wednesday, April 7, 1999, and it will be so dated. Early offers, except as specified in the preceding sentence, will not be accepted. Offers deposited in the drop box shall be considered filed and will be processed.

FORM OF NONCOMPETITIVE OFFERS: In accordance with the regulations codified at 43 CFR 3110.5, noncompetitive offers filed on the first business day following the close of the oral auction, in the drop box at the auction site, or during the remainder of the sale month (through April 30, 1999) MUST describe the lands SOLELY by the parcel number appearing in this Notice of Competitive Oil and Gas Lease Sale, i.e., WY-9904-001, WY-9904-002, etc. Thereafter, all noncompetitive oil and gas lease offers MUST be filed by legal land description. The filing of any such noncompetitive lease offer constitutes consent by the offeror to the terms and conditions, including lease stipulations, set out for the parcel in this Notice of Competitive Oil and Gas Lease Sale. All noncompetitive oil and gas lease offers must be submitted on the

current lease Form 3100-11. If photocopies are used, they must be exact reproductions on one page of both sides (head to toe) of the official form. Each noncompetitive offer MUST be accompanied by: 1) A \$75 NONREFUNDABLE filing fee; and 2) the first-year's advance rental of \$1.50 per acre or fraction thereof. Noncompetitive oil and gas lease offers that are not filed in accordance with regulations at 43 CFR Subpart 3110 shall be rejected.

LEGAL DESCRIPTIONS: The Notice of Competitive Lease Sale is prepared and processed with land status information extracted directly from the Automated Lands and Minerals Record System (ALMRS). Lands described in this Notice are in essentially the same format as used by ALMRS.

1. The townships and ranges contain extraneous zeros (examples underlined).

2. ALMRS will code a 1/2 township as a 2 in the database. This 2 will appear as the last digit in the number.
3. Section numbers contain extraneous leading zeros.
4. Lands are described separately by lots, aliquot parts, tracts, and exceptions to survey for each section.
5. Rights-of-way exclusions are described as to only those lands affected.
6. The former lease numbers for the lands in each parcel will no longer be included below the parcel description as in the past. The reason for this is that parcels will now be configured as requested rather than as they were previously leased. As such, the former lease number is no longer relevant.

Under Regulation 43 CFR 3101.1-2 and terms of the lease (BLM Form 3100-11), the authorized officer may require reasonable measures to minimize adverse impacts to other resource values, land uses, and users not addressed in lease stipulations at the time operations are proposed. Such reasonable measures may include, but are not limited to, modification of siting or design of facilities, timing of operations, and specification of interim and final reclamation measures, which may require relocating proposed operations up to 200 meters, but not off the leasehold, and prohibiting surface disturbance activities for up to 60 days.

The lands within this lease may include areas not specifically addressed by lease stipulations that may contain special values, may be needed for special purposes, or may require special attention to prevent damage to surface and/or other resources. This negotiation will occur prior to development and become a condition for approval when authorizing the action.

Specific threshold criteria (e.g., 500 feet from water) have been established based upon the best information available. However, geographical areas and time periods of concern must be delineated at the field level (i.e., "surface water and/or riparian areas" may include both intermittent and ephemeral water sources or may be limited to perennial surface water).
