# “The Fix It Clinic”

If you are experiencing difficulties handling your adopted wild horse, BLM Contract trainer Steve Mantle will be at the Rock Springs Horse Corrals to help you overcome training problems. \*Each adopter will receive individual instruction to ensure that you overcome what has interfered with the gentling of your animal.

Select one of the following categories that best describes your horse:

**Category A:** Horse is difficult to catch and halter. Will not allow touching or petting. Is nervous and not accepting of people.

**Category B:** Horse can be haltered. Allows limited handling of legs and feet. Not trusting of people.

**Category C:** Horse can be haltered and allows limited brushing and handling of legs and feet. Is wary of being saddled and excessive handling.

**Category D:** Horse has been saddled. Good to handle on the ground. Does not readily accept commands from rider.

This one day clinic will be held at the Rock Springs Horse Corrals beginning at 9:00 a.m. on July 9, 2004. Clinic is limited to 10 adopters. Please call 1-307-352-0292 or 1-307-322-5799, before July 6 to reserve a slot. There is no charge to participate or to observe. Our goal is to assist you in the gentling of your wild horse and ensure you enjoy your adoption experience!

\*We do not guarantee that all problems will be fixed with your horse in a one day clinic.  
Depending on the severity of the situation it may take more time to correct.
