

**JACKSON HOLE FIRE/EMS  
FIRE PREVENTION ORDER**

**WILDFIRE PREVENTION RESTRICTIONS  
"PARTIAL FIRE CLOSURE"**

As approved by Resolution of the Teton County Board of County Commissioners and pursuant to Wyoming Statute, §35-9-101 through §35-9-130, §35-9-301 through §35-9-304, Teton County Fire Protection Resolution, adopted January 20<sup>th</sup>, 1998, and Town of Jackson Municipal Code, Chapter 15.08, Ordinance 591, the following acts are prohibited on all public and private lands within Teton County, Wyoming.

1. Building, maintaining, attending or using any campfire, except within established campfire grates or rings, which are not less than 25 feet from structures or brush or tree covered areas. Open burning of trash, grass, brush or tree cuttings, and construction debris is prohibited. The use of enclosed stoves or grills, and stoves using liquid or gas fuels is not restricted.
2. Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site, or while stopped in an area at least three feet in diameter that is barren of cleared of all flammable material.
3. Operating a chainsaw without a USDA or SAE approved spark arresting device properly installed and in effective working order, and a chemical pressurized fire extinguisher with a minimum rating of 2A, and one round point shovel with an overall length of at least 36 inches.
4. Using a welder, either arc or gas, or operating an acetylene or other torch, or open flame device, except in cleared areas at least 10 feet in diameter and with a chemical pressurized fire extinguisher with a minimum rating of 2A.
5. Using explosive devices requiring fuse blasting caps, tracer bullets or tracer charges, or rockets or model aircraft using propellant type engines.

This Fire Prevention Order becomes effective at \_\_\_\_\_ hours, July \_\_, 2012 and shall remain in effect until rescinded.
