



TOWNSHIP 20 NORTH, RANGE 71 WEST, OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the east boundary and a portion of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the survey of the subdivision of section 12, and the metes-and-bounds survey of Lot 1, section 12, T. 20 N., R. 71 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lotting and areas are as shown on the plat approved October 24, 1874.


