


TOWNSHIP 26 NORTH, RANGE 72 WEST, OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the survey of the subdivision of sections 4, 8, 9 and 17, T. 26 N., R. 72 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lotting and areas are as shown on the plat approved January 3, 1885.
