This plat represents a retracement and reestablishment of a portion of the south and west boundaries of section 28, T. 27 N., R. 71 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and a partial subdivision thereof. The lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved January 3, 1885, and the plat accepted June 19, 1944.

This township was subdivided by R. M. Jones, Deputy Surveyor, in 1884, and resurveyed by Leo M. Petersen, Cadastral Surveyor, under Group No. 163, Wyoming, in 1939.

MEMORANDUM

This plat of the resurvey of Township No. 27 North, Range No. 71 West, delineates a retracement and reestablishment of the lines of the original survey as shown upon the plat approved January 3, 1885, in their true original position according to the best available evidence of the position of the original corners; all differences between the measurements shown on the original plat and those derived in the retracement have been distributed proportionally between accepted corners in accordance with surveying rules; reference will be made to the original plat for the showing of the areas and more detailed description of the various smaller subdivisions, except in sections where new areas and designations are shown.

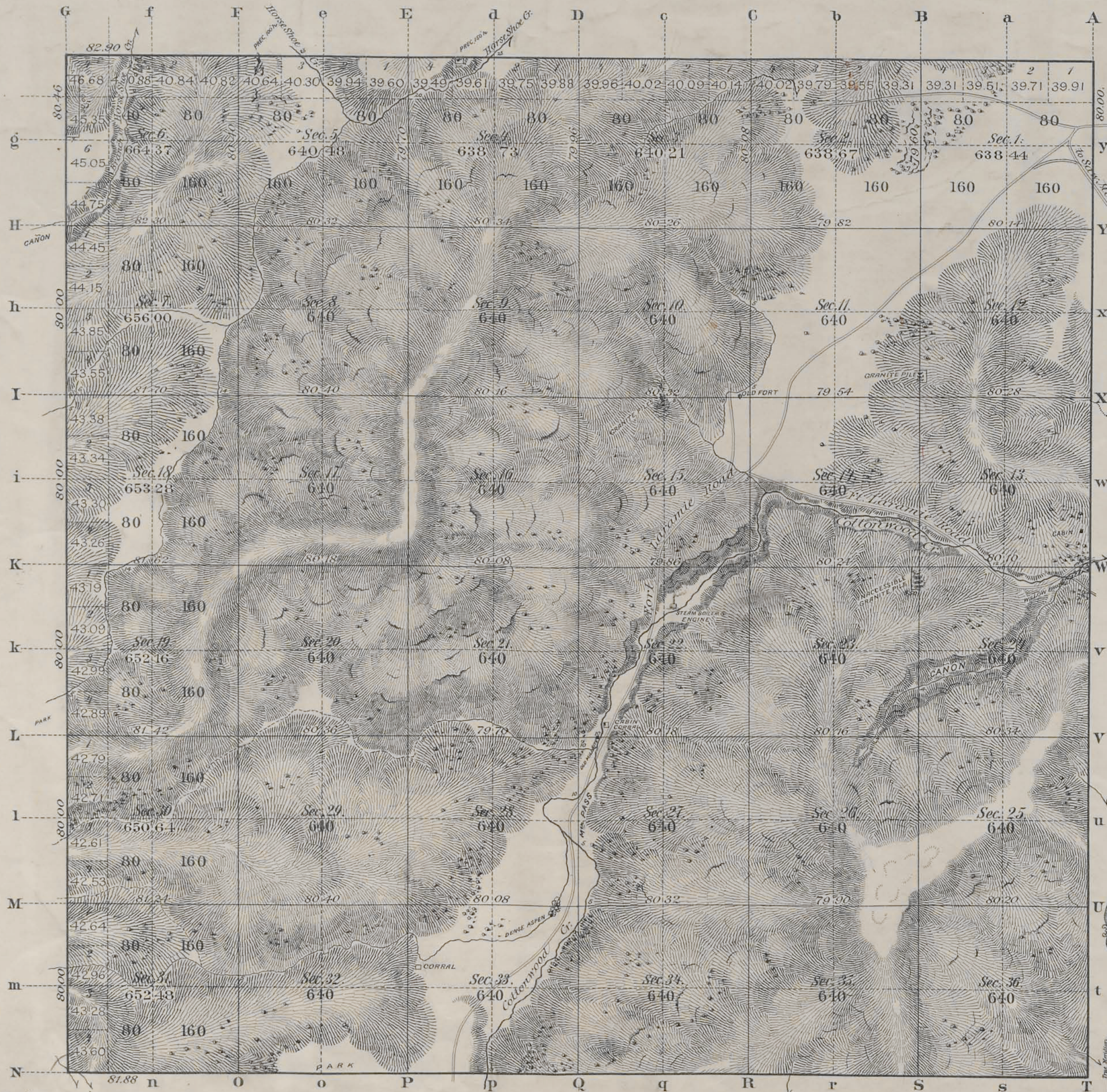
