TOWNSHIP 51 NORTH, RANGE 97 WEST, OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

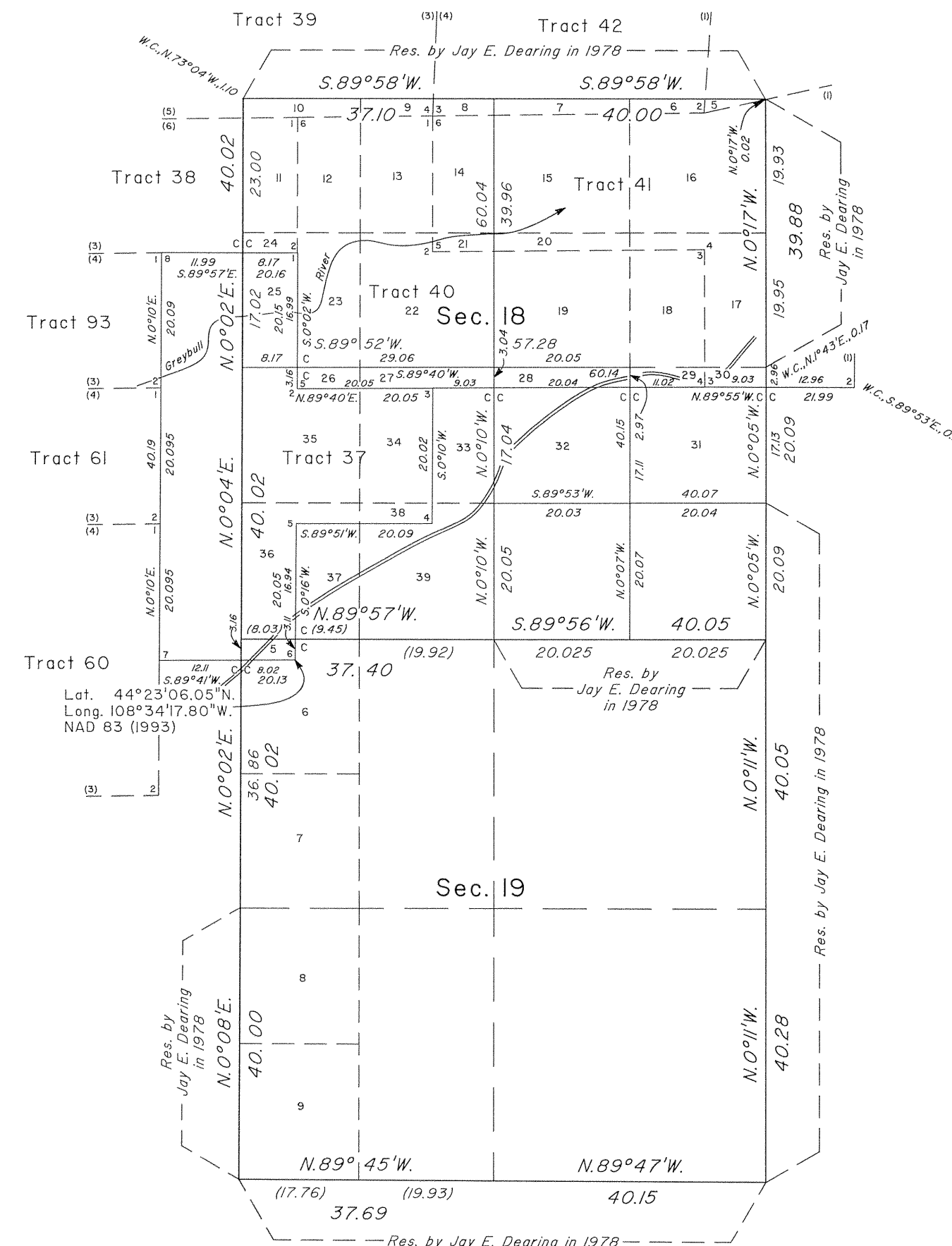
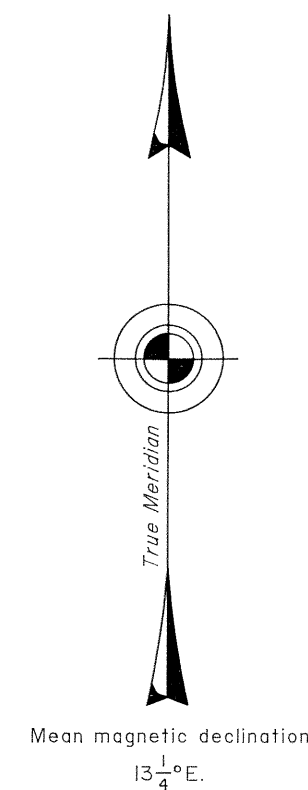
