


TOWNSHIP 52 NORTH, RANGE 91 WEST, OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY



A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the Thirteenth Standard Parallel North, through Range 91 West, and a portion of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, T. 52 N., R. 91 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lotting and areas are as shown on the plat approved August 10, 1914.
