



TOWNSHIP 57 NORTH, RANGE 95 WEST, OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the corrective dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines and the dependent resurvey of portions of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, the survey of the subdivision of certain sections, and the metes and bounds survey of Lot 1, section 33, T. 57 N., R. 95 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lotting and areas are as shown on the plat approved October 21, 1895.

Solid lines not returning a bearing and distance were resurveyed by Lynn A. Forbes in 1988.
