


TOWNSHIP 12 NORTH, RANGE 91 WEST, OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY AND SUBDIVISION OF SECTION 17



A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the retracement of a portion of the Wyoming-Colorado State Boundary, through Range 91 West, the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of Section 17, T. 12 N., R. 91 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lotting and areas are as shown on the plat approved April 20, 1881.

Survey executed by Sonja S. Sparks, Cadastral Surveyor, beginning September 21, 2009, and completed November 2, 2010, pursuant to Special Instructions and Assignment Instructions dated September 3, 2009, for Group No. 810, Wyoming.
