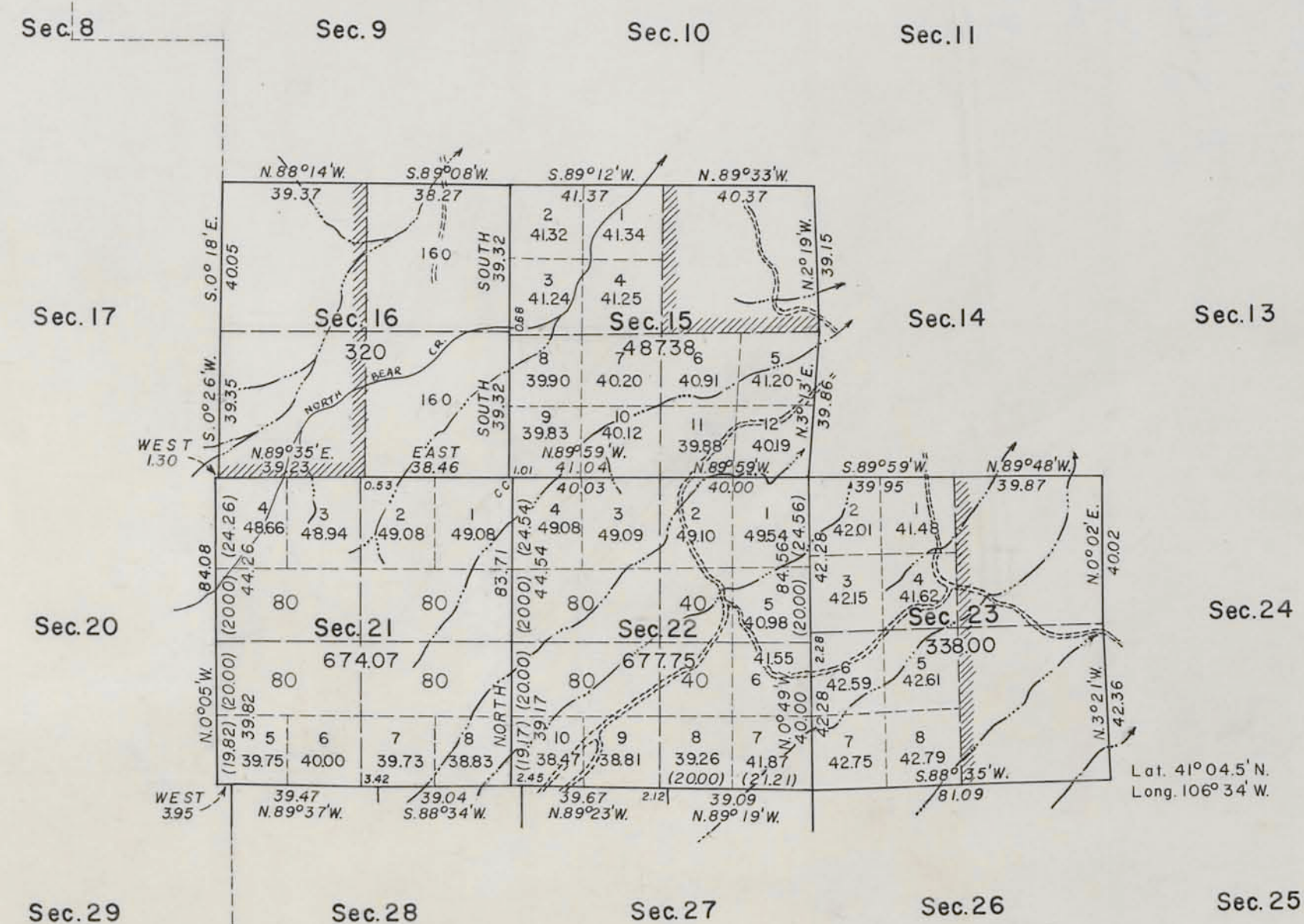
Reference will be made to plats approved June 30, 1891 and September 12, 1901 for lottings and areas except as to the lands returned as surveyed hereon.

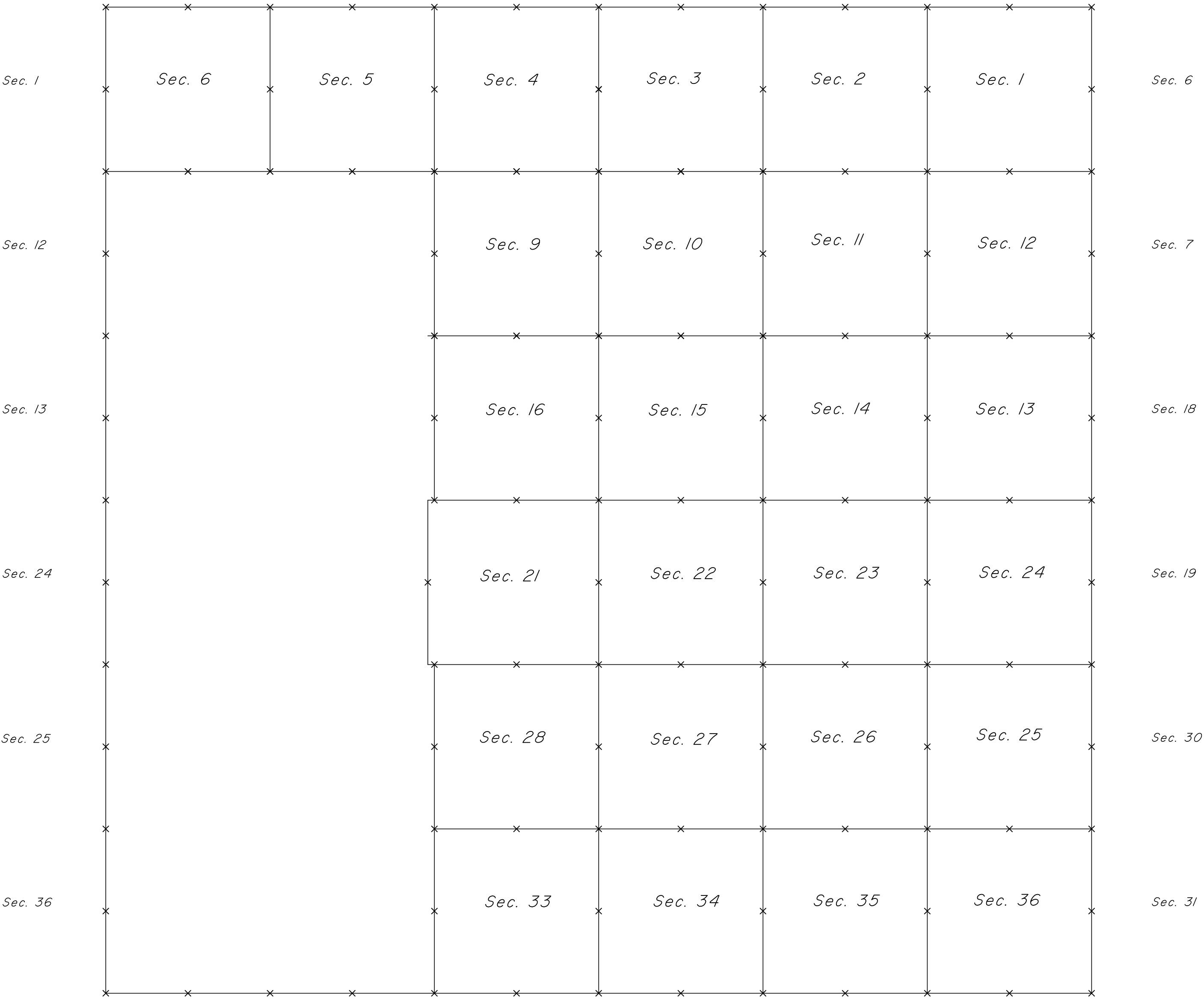

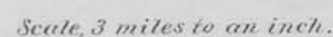
