


# TOWNSHIP 16 NORTH, RANGE 86 WEST, OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

Surveyed by Howard B. Carpenter in 1898




A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of portions of the west boundary and subdivisional lines designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the survey of the subdivision of certain sections, T. 16 N., R. 86 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved June 20, 1899.

Survey executed by Carl W. Sumpter, Supervisory Cadastral Surveyor (USFS), beginning July 9, 1997, and completed July 9, 1998, pursuant to Special Instructions dated July 9, 1996, for Group No. 626, Wyoming.
