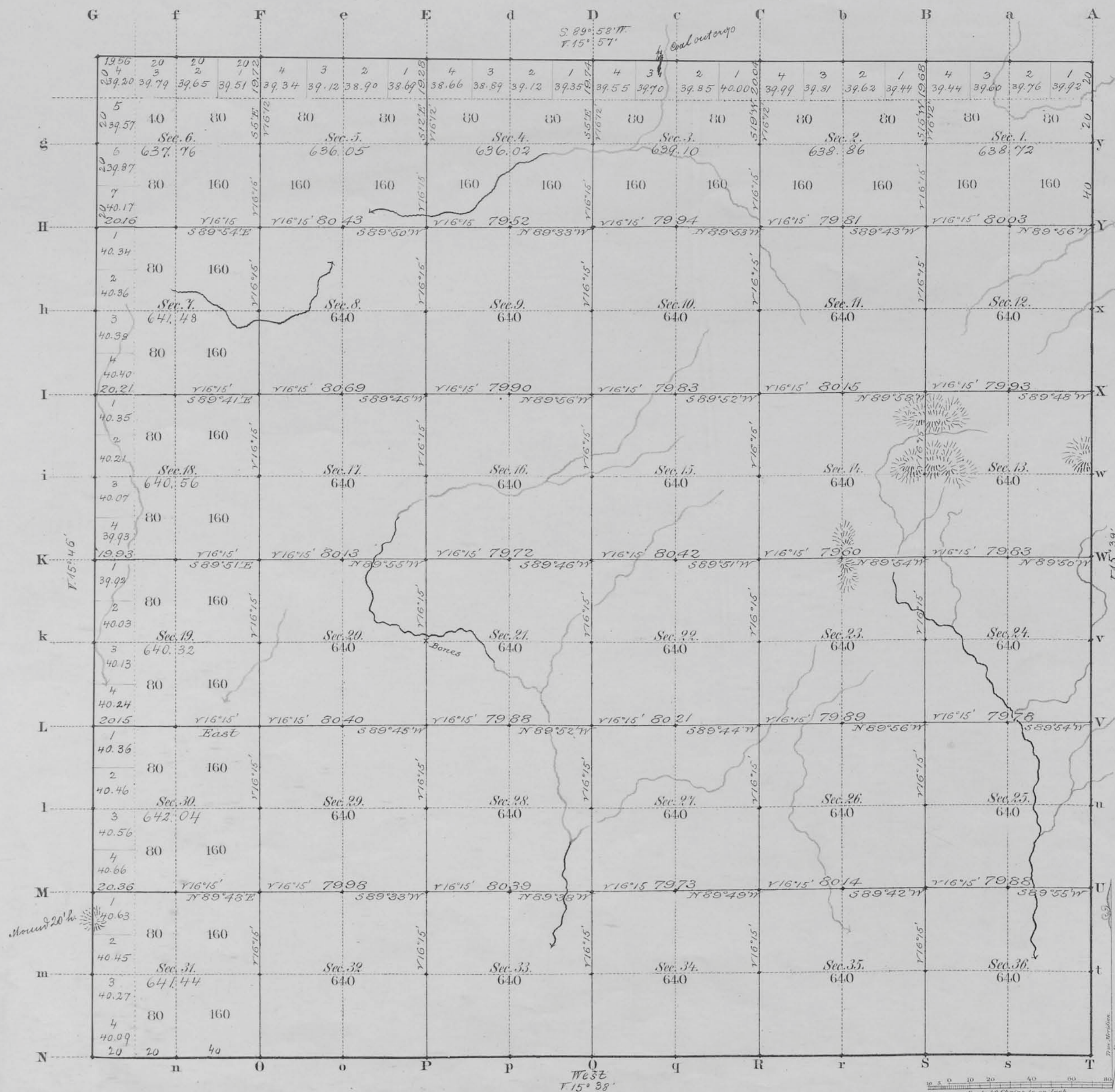

TOWNSHIP N^o 18 NORTH RANGE N^o 92 WEST of the 6th Principal MERIDIAN.



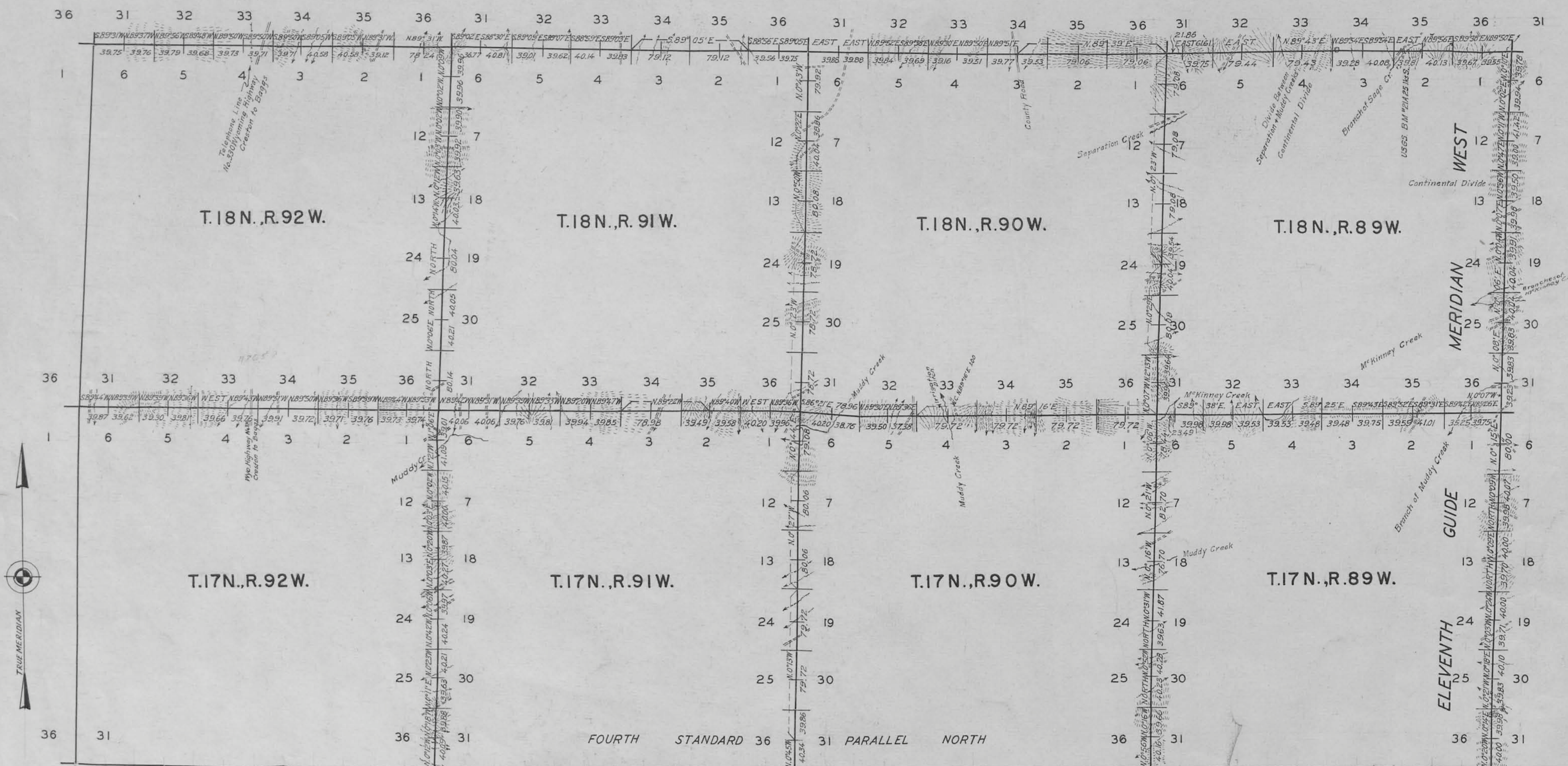

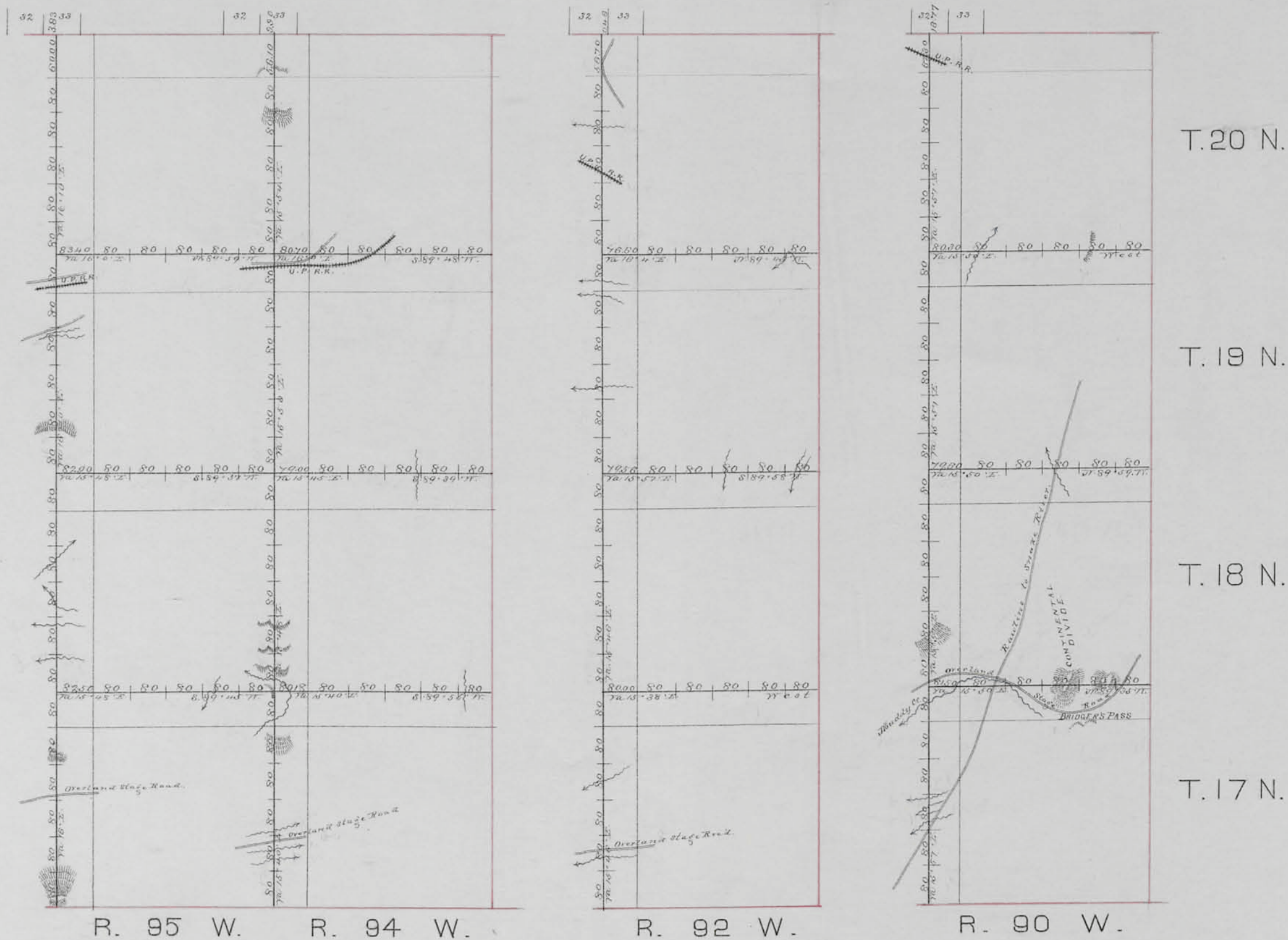
