


TOWNSHIP 20 NORTH, RANGE 89 WEST, OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.
DEPENDENT RESURVEY



A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

The Fifth Standard Parallel North, through R. 89 W., was dependently resurveyed by William H. Herbst during the resurvey of T. 21 N., R. 89 W., executed concurrently under this same group.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the Fifth Standard Parallel North, through R. 88 W., a portion of the Eleventh Guide Meridian West, through T. 20 N., between Rs. 88 and 89 W., portions of the south and west boundaries, and the subdivisional lines designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, T. 20 N., R. 89 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved October 22, 1875.

Survey executed by William H. Herbst, Supervisory Cadastral Surveyor, beginning June 6, 1980, and completed July 18, 1980, pursuant to Special Instructions dated April 28, 1980, for Group No. 411, Wyoming.





 DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF EXTERIOR LINES






