




TOWNSHIP 22 NORTH, RANGE 80 WEST, OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.


DEPENDENT RESURVEY, SUBDIVISION OF SECTION 26, AND METES AND BOUNDS SURVEY
