DEPENDENT RESURVEY AND SUBDIVISION OF SECTION 7



A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the west boundary, and a portion of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of section 7, T. 26 N., R. 81 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lotting and areas are as shown on the plats approved April 16, 1884 and July 11, 1936.

Mineral Survey No. 323, Shirley Mountain No. 2, is shown for informational purposes only. Reference should be made to the plats approved March 28, 1905, June 11, 1936, and April 20, 1967, for more detailed mineral survey information.
