



TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 76 WEST, OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY AND SUBDIVISION OF SECTIONS 13 AND 24



A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the east boundary and a portion of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the survey of the subdivision of sections 13 and 24, T. 29 N., R. 76 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lotting and areas are as shown on the plat approved May 16, 1945.

Survey executed by Carl W. Sumpter, Supervisory Cadastral Surveyor (USFS), beginning August 1, 1996, and completed November 5, 1999, pursuant to Special Instructions dated July 29, 1996, for Group No. 628, Wyoming.
