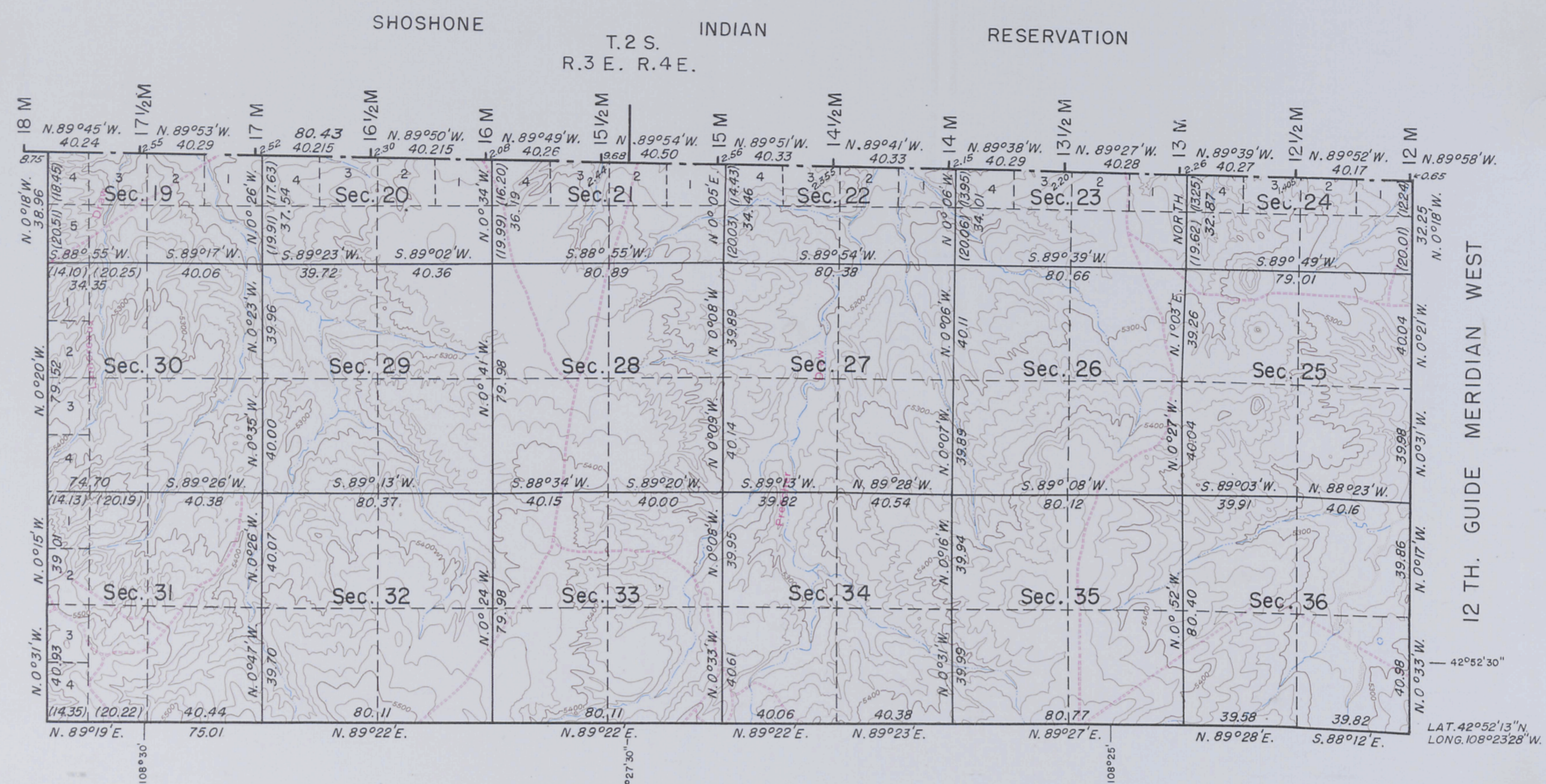

This plat represents a retracement and re-establishment of the South boundary, a portion of the East boundary, and a portion of the South boundary of the Shoshone Indian Reservation through Range 97 West, and the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their original locations according to the best available evidence. The lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved June 8, 1893.

Resurvey executed by Russell C. MacDonald June 13, 1952 to July 2, 1952, under special instructions dated May 5, 1945 for Group 207, Wyoming.

A portion of the West boundary was resurveyed by R. C. MacDonald in 1952.

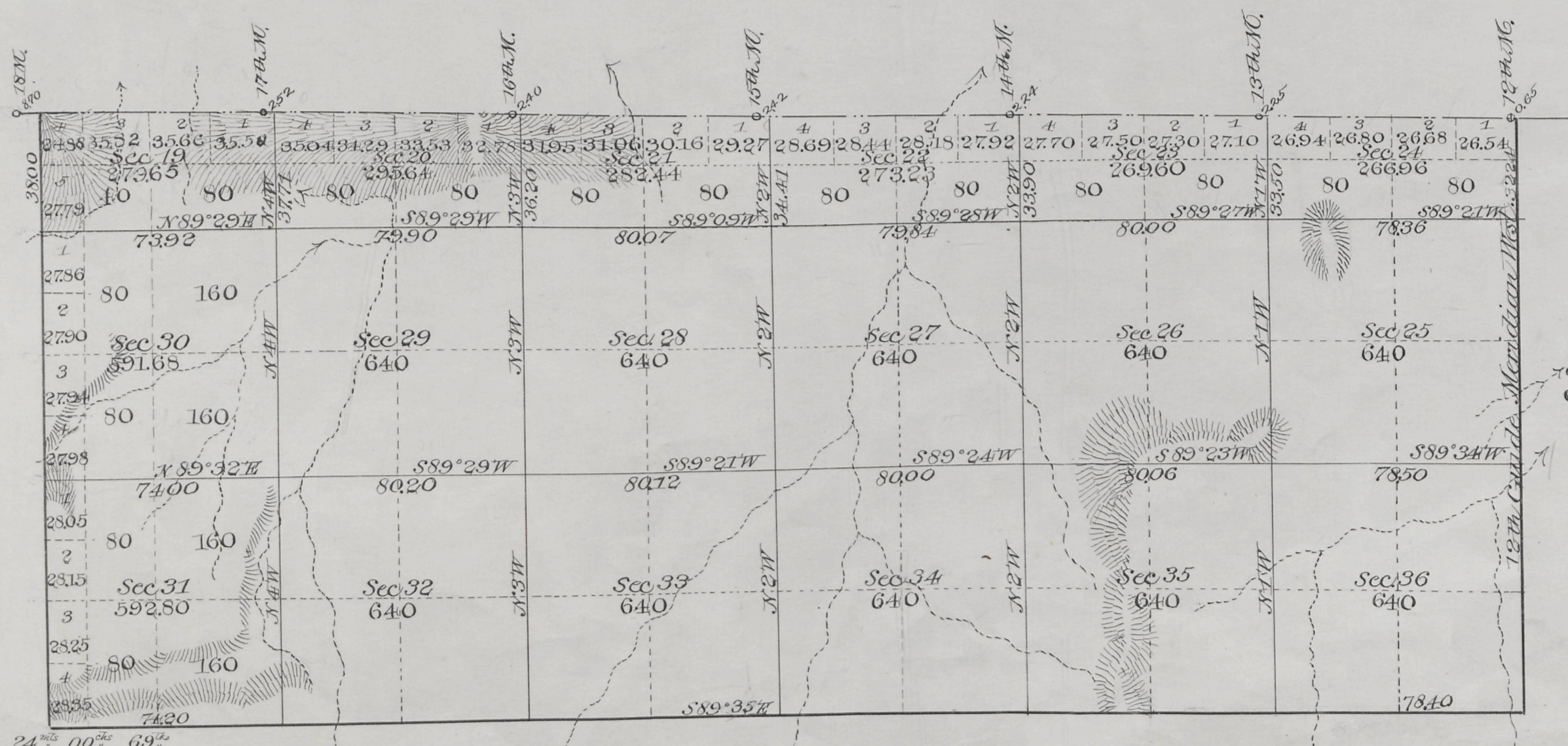

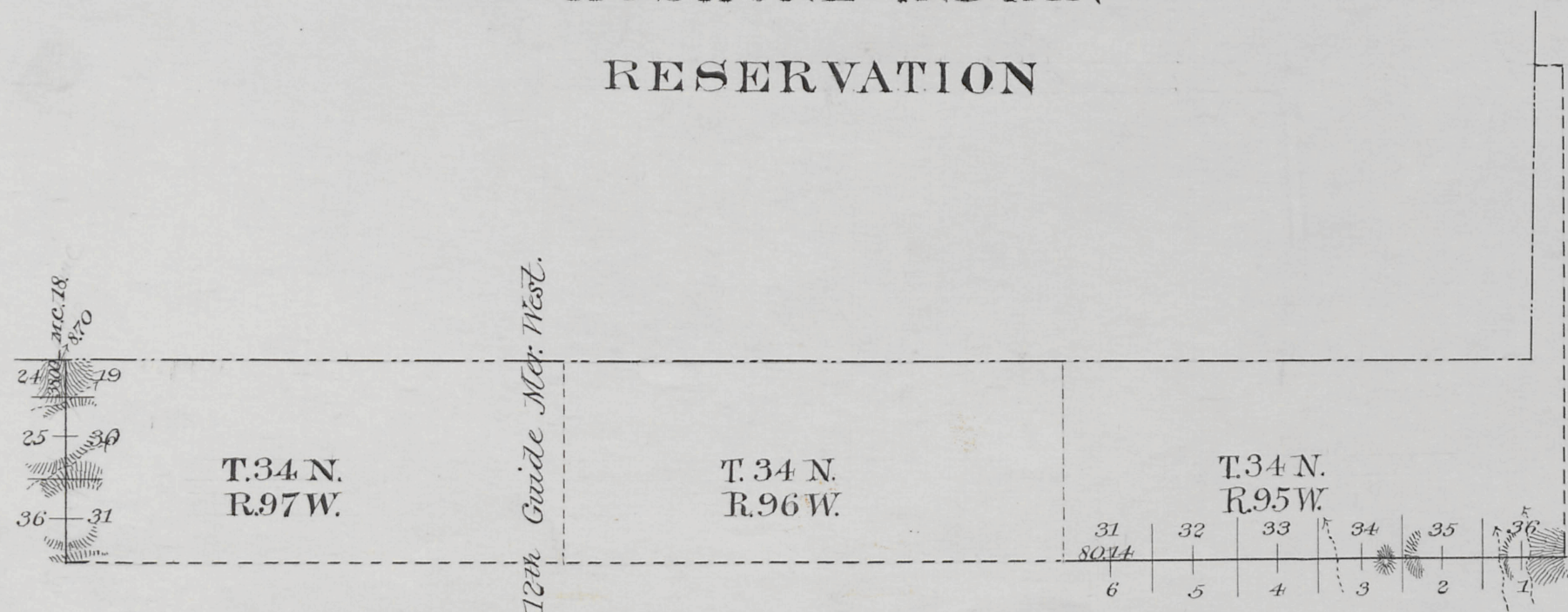

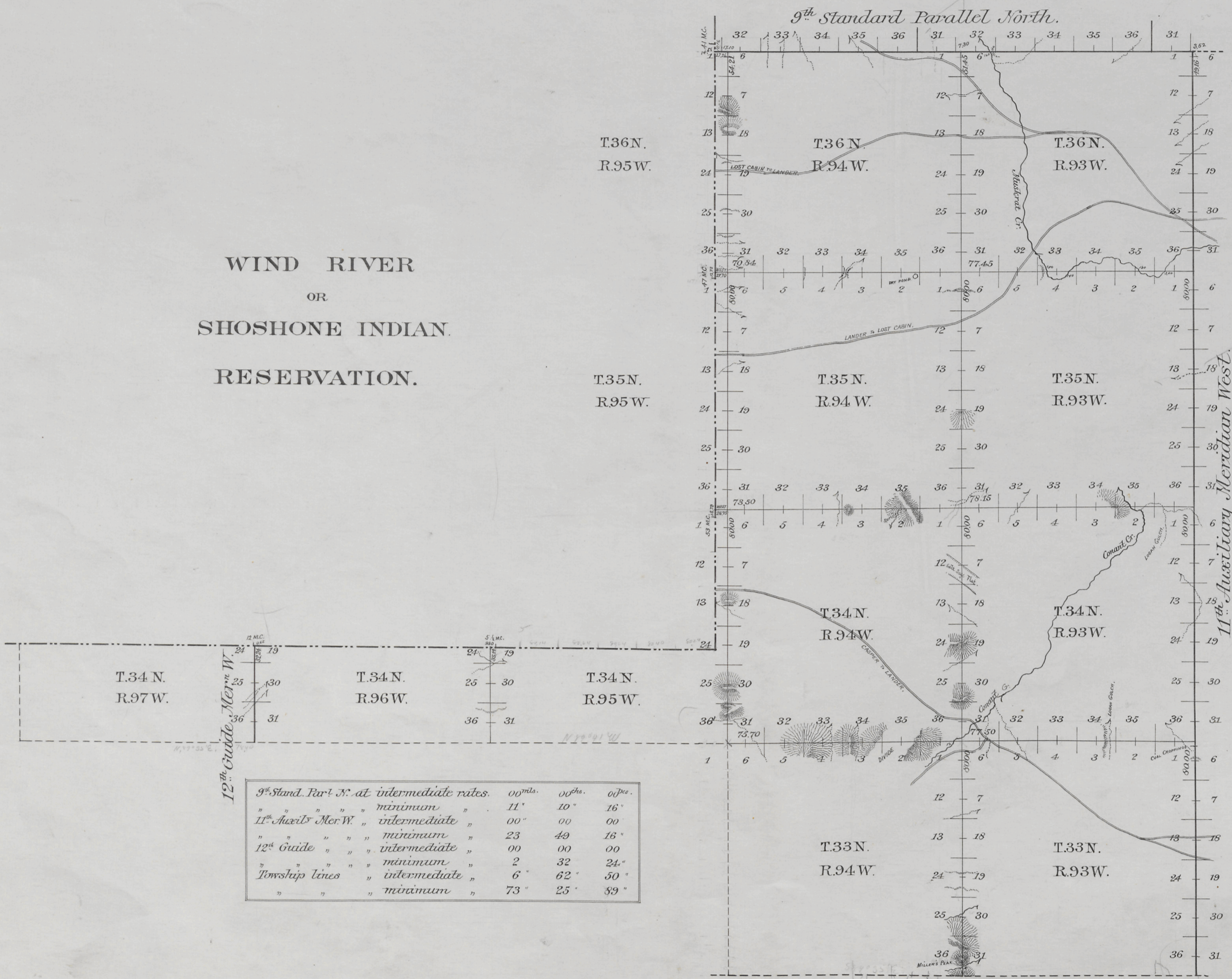
