REMONUMENTATION OF CERTAIN CORNERS

(A) The closing cor. of secs. 25 and 26, monumented with a limestone, 15 x 8 x 4 ins., firmly set, 10 ins. in the ground, in supporting mound of stone, 3 ft. dia., 1 1/2 ft. high, plainly mkd. CC on S. face, with 1 notch on E. edge, no other mks. visible.

At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 21 ins. in the ground, in supporting mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, atop a plastic encased magnetic marker, with brass cap mkd.

Bury the mkd. stone and set a steel fence post alongside the stainless steel post.

Cor. is located 140 lks. W. of the westerly rim of the Wind River Canyon, draining N., on gently rolling ground in scattered juniper timber.

Note: This position is filed in the Hot Springs County Clerk's Office by R. L. Hudson, Wyoming Professional Land Surveyor No. 519, as document No. 377973. Mr. Hudson reported finding the limestone in 1990, mkd. CC on the south face and 1 notch on the east ace, firmly set, projecting 6 ins. above the ground, with the remains of a mound of stone. He then rebuilt mound of stone as a collar of stone.

The geographic position of this cor. is:

Latitude 43° 34' 45.897" N., Longitude 108° 12' 56.169" W.

(B) The closing cor. of secs. 26 and 27, monumented with a broken limestone, top portion 13 x 13 x 3 ins., firmly set 7 ins. in the ground, plainly mkd. C on S. face, no other mks. visible, bottom portion of limestone shattered, size indeterminate, set beneath, with mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1/2 ft. high N. of cor., and a steel fence post set alongside.

Note: This position is filed in the Hot Springs County Clerk's Office by R. L. Hudson, Wyoming Professional Land Surveyor No. 519, as document No. 473980. Mr. Hudson rehabilitated this monument in 2007.

At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 21 ins. in the ground, in supporting mound of stone, 2 ft. dia., to top, atop a plastic encased magnetic marker, with brass cap mkd.

Cor. is located in open, rolling ground.

(C) The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 23 and 26, monumented with a sandstone, 16 x 12 x 4 ins., firmly set 12 ins. in the ground, plainly mkd. 1/4 on N. face., with mound of stone 2 1/2 ft. base, 1 ft. high N. of cor.,

At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, in collar of stone, atop a plastic encased magnetic marker, with brass cap mkd.


Bury the mkd. stone alongside the stainless steel post.

SURVEY INFORMATION AND CERTIFICATE

This plat represents the entire record of the remonumentation of certain corners, Township 42 North, Range 95 West, Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

This history of surveys pertaining to this remonumentation is as follows:

1899 - Edward F. Stahle, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, surveyed the south boundary of The 10 Mile Square (North Boundary of Wind River Indian Reservation) and the subdivisional lines, Township 42 North, Range 95 West.

Local surveys have been executed in the area and acceptance of these are contained herein.

Geographic positions, referenced to the NAD 83(2011) (EPOCH:2010) datum, were determined by TRIMBLE Model RIO-2 and RI2 Global Positioning System /Global Navigation Satellite Systems (GPS/GNSS) receivers

The magnetic declination was not observed.

I, James R. Gampetro, HEREBY CERTIFY upon honor that, in pursuance of special instructions dated June 13, 2011, and assignment instructions dated September 14, 2022, for Group Number 850, Wyoming, I have remonumented certain corners, Township 42 North, Range 95 West, Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming, and that this plat in one sheet represents the entire record of this remonumentation. Fieldwork commenced September 20, 2022, and completed October 27, 2022, has been made in strict conformity with the special instructions, the Manual of Instructions for the Survey of Public Lands of the United States, 2009, and in the specific manner described hereon.


