

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of portions of the Sixth Standard Parallel North, through Range 7 East, the east boundary, the subdivisional lines, and the subdivision of section lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the survey of the subdivision of certain sections, T. 24 N., R. 7 E., Sixth Principal Meridian, Nebraska.

Except as indicated hereon, the lotting and areas are as shown on the plat approved March 4, 1867.


