


TOWNSHIP 31 NORTH, RANGE 5 WEST, OF THE 6TH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, NEBRASKA.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY AND SUBDIVISION OF SECTIONS



A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of portions of the west and north boundaries, and portions of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the survey of the subdivision of certain sections, T. 31 N., R. 5 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Nebraska.

Except as indicated hereon, the lotting and areas are as shown on the plat approved July 20, 1859.
