

A portion of the east boundary was dependently resurveyed by Michael W. Beale during the dependent resurvey of a portion of T. 34 N., R. 54 W., executed concurrently under this same group.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, the subdivision of section 13, and the metes and bounds survey of Lot I, section 13, T. 34 N., R. 55 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Nebraska.

Except as indicated hereon, the lotting and areas are as shown on the plat approved April 12, 1884.
