DEPENDENT RESURVEY AND SUBDIVISION OF LOT 41


A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the Thirteenth Standard Parallel North, Through Range 100 West, and Lot 41, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of Lot 41, T. 53 N., R. 100 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lotting and areas are as shown on the plats approved January 15, 1907, August 24, 1909, June 13, 1914, and June 4, 1920, and the plat accepted November 30, 1939.

Survey executed by James E. Jacob, Cadastral Surveyor, beginning May 4, 2009, and completed July 29, 2010, pursuant to Special Instructions and Assignment Instructions dated April 7, 2009, and Supplemental Special Instructions dated May 26, 2009, for Group No. 802, Wyoming.
