


TOWNSHIP 57 NORTH, RANGE 101 WEST, OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the north boundary and a portion of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of sections 4 and 10, T. 57 N., R. 101 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lotting and areas are as shown on the plat approved November 26, 1892.




