



TOWNSHIP 27 NORTH, RANGE 103 WEST, OF THE 6TH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the north boundary and subdivisional lines designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of section 4, and the metes and bounds survey of Lots 5 and 6, Section 4, T. 27 N., R. 103 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved February 8, 1884.
