


TOWNSHIP 34 NORTH, RANGE 110 WEST, OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.




A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

The lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved June 25, 1894.


