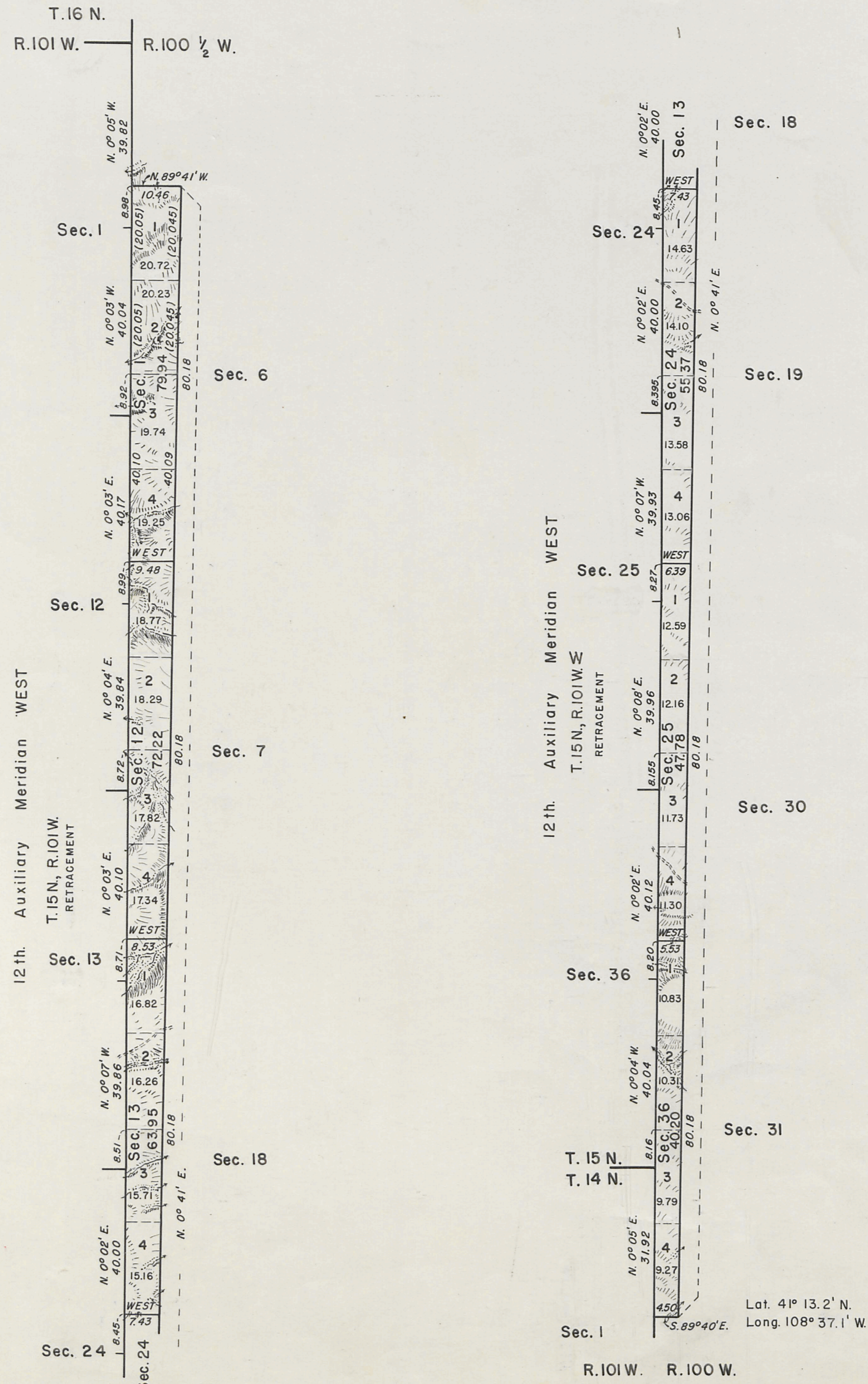
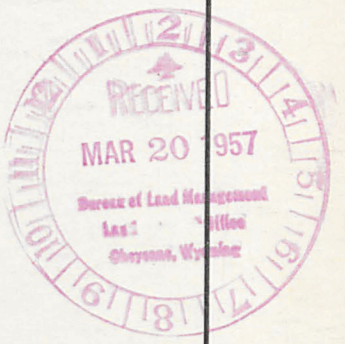

This plat represents a retracement of the Twelfth Auxiliary Meridian West through T. 15 N., a resurvey of the West boundary of T. 15 N., R. 100 W., a resurvey of a portion of the North boundary of section 6, T. 14 N., R. 100 W., designed to restore the corners in their original locations according to the best available evidence; and a survey of the North boundary and subdivisional lines.

The history of the earlier surveys creating this hiatus is set forth in the field note record.

The land is rolling and broken range land with no timber.

The South boundary was resurveyed by Saxon and Saxon in 1912. The West boundary was resurveyed by Burnham in 1911.

Survey of North boundary and subdivisional lines of T. 15 N., R. 100 1/2 W., dependent resurvey of a portion of the North boundary of sect 6, T. 14 N., R. 100 W., and retracement of the Twelfth Auxiliary Meridian West through T. 15 N., executed by Russell C. Mac Donald, May 22 to 29, 1953, under supplemental special instructions for Group 12, Wyoming dated March 20, 1953.
