


TOWNSHIP 26 NORTH, RANGE 105 WEST, OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY



A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the survey of the subdivision of section 33, T. 26 N., R. 105 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

The lotting and areas are as shown on the plat approved February 24, 1892.
