


TOWNSHIP 41 NORTH, RANGE 117 WEST, OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

METES-AND-BOUNDS DESCRIPTION - TRACT 46B

Beginning at Point No. 1, Tract 46B, on the 2006 right bank of the Snake River (approximation determined from aerial photography). Not monumented.

Thence N.76°00'58"W., on line 1-2, per Maps T-99D and E, recorded in Book 2MAP, Page 225; and Judgment Re: United States of America and Gene Jarvis and Angie Jarvis, recorded in Book 234 Photo, Pages 782-792; all at the Teton County Clerk's office in Jackson, Wyoming, 518.26 ft., to A.P. 9 of Tract 45, per 1987 legal description record (Riparian Descriptions for Tract 45). Continue on same bearing, on line 1-2, 604.20 ft. to Point No. 2, Tract 46B, per Maps T-99D and E, recorded in Book 2MAP, Page 225, at the Teton County Clerk's office in Jackson, Wyoming. Monumented with a galvanized steel post 2 1/2 ins. diam., with brass cap inscribed "SCOTT A. SCHERBEL PLS 3889".

Thence N.76°00'58"W., on line 2-3, per Maps T-99D and E, recorded in Book 2MAP, Page 225; and Judgment Re: United States of America and Gene Jarvis and Angie Jarvis, recorded in Book 234 Photo, Pages 782-792; all at the Teton County Clerk's office in Jackson, Wyoming, 575.98 ft. to A.P. 8 of Tract 45, per 1987 legal description record (Riparian Descriptions for Tract 45). Continue on same bearing, on line 2-3, 615.61 ft. to Point No. 3, Tract 46B, identical with the meander corner of secs. 13 and 24, on the right bank of the Snake River. Monumented with a BLM iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam.

Thence S.67°52'44"W., on line 3-4, identical with the line between secs. 13 and 24, per Maps T-99D and E, recorded in Book 2MAP, Page 225, at the Teton County Clerk's office in Jackson, Wyoming, 30.05 ft. to Point No. 4, Tract 46B, identical with the cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24. Monumented with a BLM iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam.



Thence S.0°41'04"W., on line 4-5, identical with the line between secs. 23 and 24, per Maps T-99D and E, recorded in Book 2MAP, Page 225, at the Teton County Clerk's office in Jackson, Wyoming, 29.60 ft. to Point No. 5, Tract 46B, identical with the meander corner of secs. 23 and 24, on the right bank of the Snake River. Monumented with a BLM iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam.

Thence S.76°00'49"E., on line 5-6, per Maps T-99D and E, recorded in Book 2MAP, Page 225, and Judgment Re: United States of America and William M. Smith and Estella J. Smith, recorded in Book 246, Pages 313-325; all at the Teton County Clerk's office in Jackson, Wyoming, 656.76 ft. to Point No. 6, Tract 46B, per Maps T-99D and E, recorded in Book 2MAP, Page 225, at the Teton County Clerk's office in Jackson, Wyoming. Monumented with a 5/8 in. diam. rebar, no cap.

Thence S.76°00'49"E., on line 6-7, per Maps T-99D and E, recorded in Book 2MAP, Page 225, and Judgment Re: United States of America and William M. Smith and Estella J. Smith, recorded in Book 246, Pages 313-325; all at the Teton County Clerk's office in Jackson, Wyoming, 656.76 ft. to Point No. 6, Tract 46B, per Maps T-99D and E, recorded in Book 2MAP, Page 225, at the Teton County Clerk's office in Jackson, Wyoming, 573.33 ft. to Point No. 7, Tract 46B, on the 2006 right bank of the Snake River (approximation determined from aerial photography). Not Monumented.

Thence N.31°33"E., on line 7-1 (ambulatory), along the 2006 right bank of the Snake River (approximation determined from aerial photography), 39.02 ft. to Point No. 1, Tract 46B, and the point of beginning. Containing 1.06 acres, more or less.

NOTE: The easterly boundary of Tract 46B is the actual thread of the Snake River, which is an ambulatory boundary that changes with the fluctuations of the river. The hatched area shown hereon is an approximation of that portion of Tract 46B that falls within the river, based on photomapping from 2006 digital aerial photography.



This plat represents the segregation of Tract 46B from Tract 46, T. 41 N., R. 117 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

The boundaries of Tract 46B are per Judgement Re: United States of America and Gene Jarvis and Angie Jarvis; and Judgement Re: United States of America and William M. Smith and Estella J. Smith, recorded in Book 234 Photo, pages 782-792, and Book 246, Pages 313-325, respectively, both at the Teton County Clerk's Office in Jackson, Wyoming. These boundaries are as depicted (allowing for trivial differences in orientation and measurement determined by local resurvey) on Maps T-99D and T-99E, both recorded in Book 2MAP Page 225, at the Teton County Clerk's Office in Jackson, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lots and areas are as shown on the plat accepted August 21, 1987.

Note: The banks and thread of the Snake River were determined by the method of photomapping from 2006 digital aerial photography.
