



TOWNSHIP 47 NORTH, RANGE 89 WEST, OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of sections 14 and 23, T. 47 N., R. 89 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

The areas are as shown on the plat approved March 27, 1920.
