



# TOWNSHIP 45 NORTH, RANGE 60 WEST, OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

## RETRACEMENT, DEPENDENT RESURVEY AND SUBDIVISION OF SECTIONS



A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the retracement of a portion of the Wyoming-South Dakota State Boundary between Mile Posts 58 and 60, and the dependent resurvey of portions of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the survey of the subdivision of sections 27 and 28, T. 45 N., R. 60 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lotting and areas are as shown on the plat approved August 12, 1882 and the plat accepted May 13, 1960.

Survey executed by James E. Jacob, Cadastral Surveyor, beginning June 17, 2013, and completed July 2, 2013, pursuant to special instructions and assignment instructions dated June 7, 2013, for Group No. 881, Wyoming.
