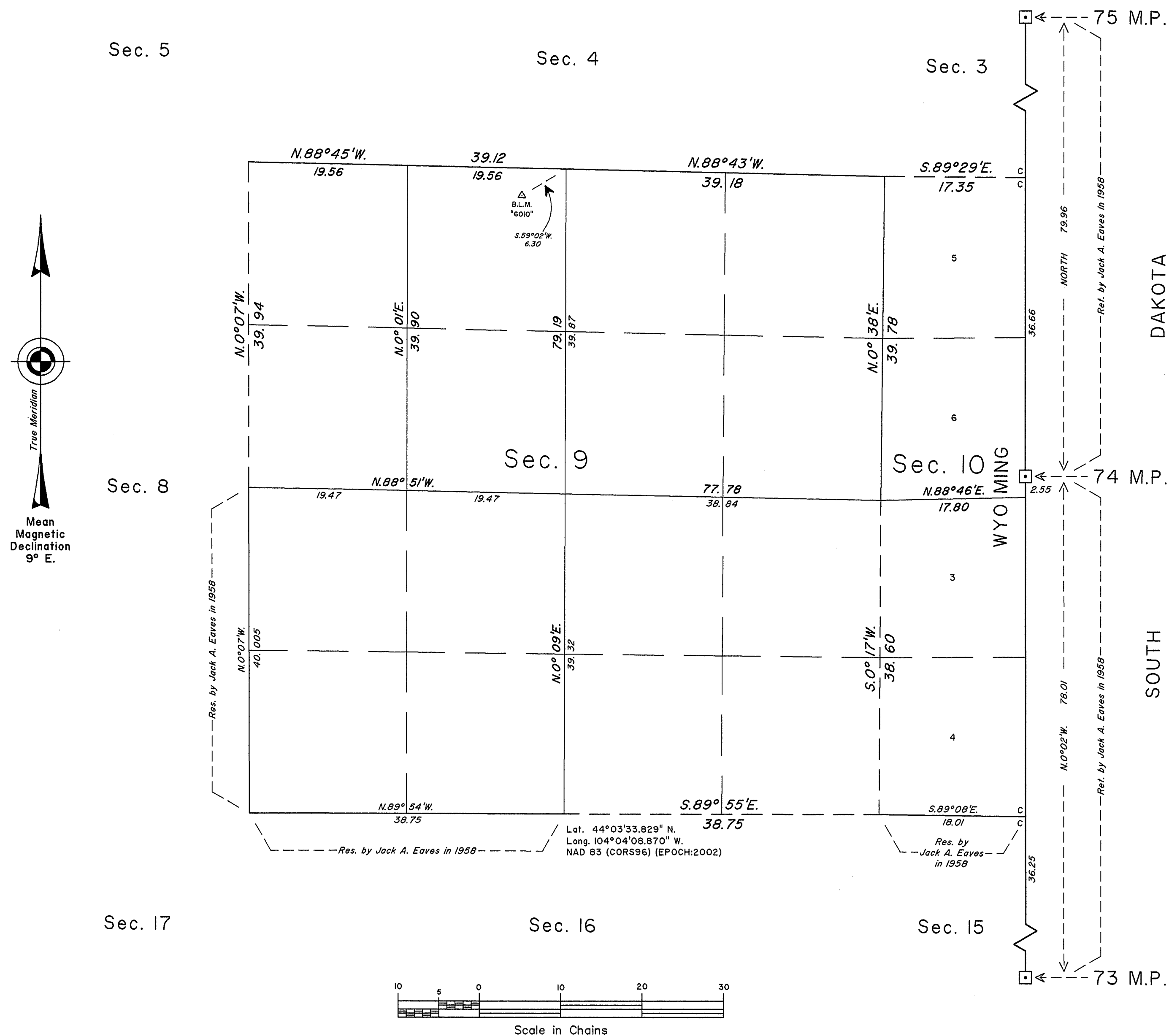

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of sections 9 and 10, T. 47 N., R. 60 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lotting and areas are as shown on the plat approved August 12, 1882, and the plat accepted May 13, 1960.

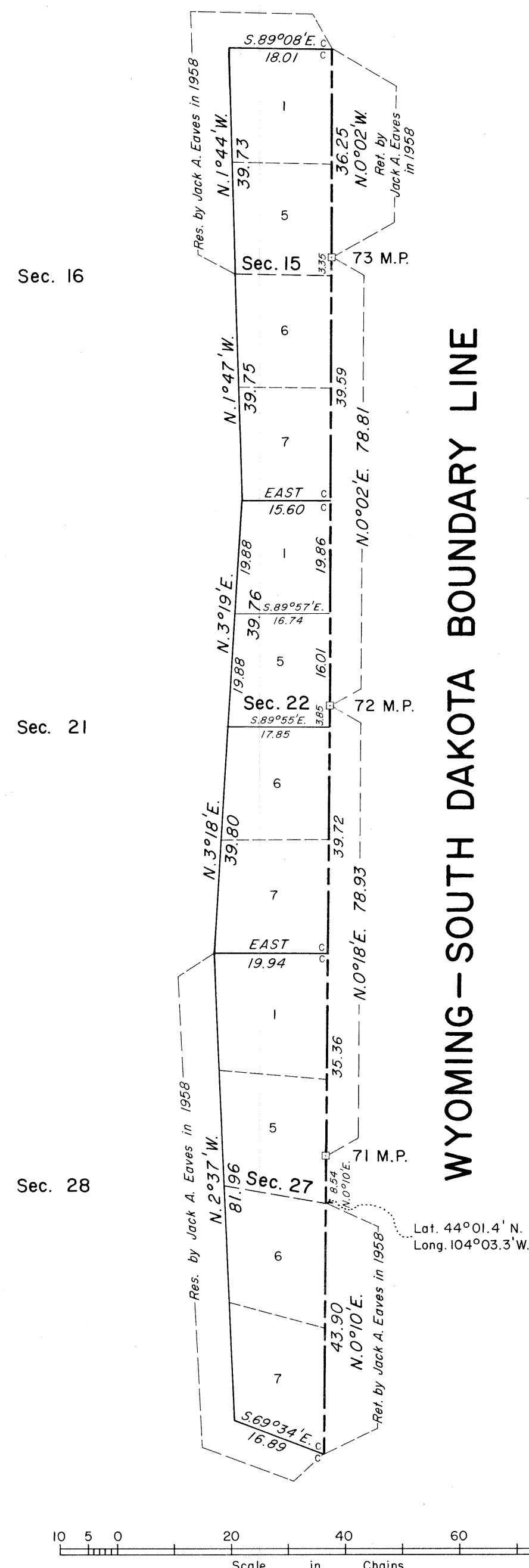
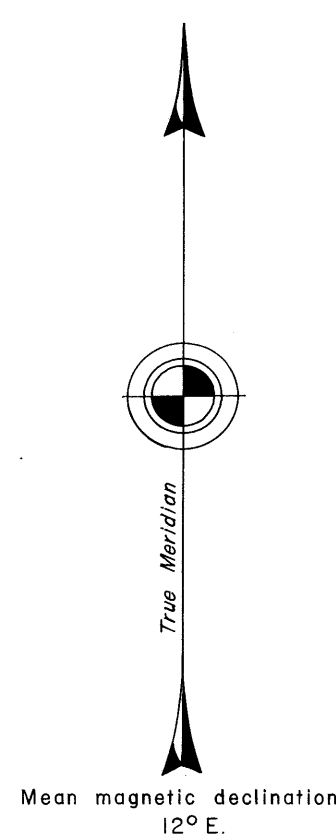

CORRECTIVE DEPENDENT RESURVEY AND DEPENDENT RESURVEY



A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the retracement of the South Dakota-Wyoming State Boundary between Mile Posts 71 and 73, the dependent resurvey and corrective dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of section 22, T. 47 N., R. 60 W., Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

The lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved August 12, 1882, and the plat accepted May 13, 1960.

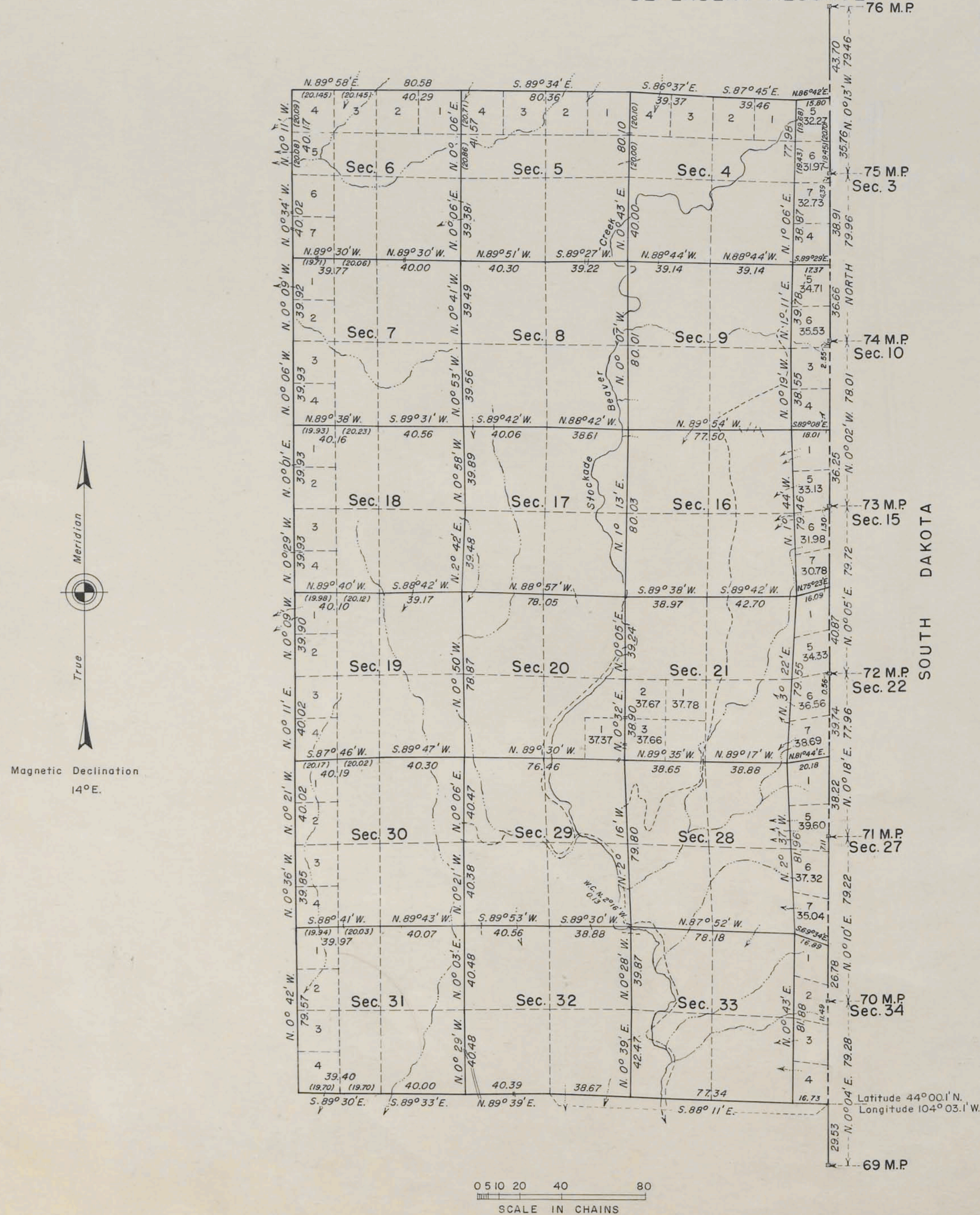

TOWNSHIP 47 NORTH, RANGE 60 WEST OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY



This plat represents a resurvey of the West boundary and the subdivisional lines with ties to the Wyoming-South Dakota State boundary of T. 47 N., R. 60 W. of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming, designed to restore the corners in their original locations according to the best available evidence. The lottings and areas are as shown upon the plat approved August 12, 1882, excepting as shown hereon.

The North boundary of the township was resurveyed by Clyde W. Atherly in 1937, the South boundary was resurveyed by Jack A. Eaves in 1958. History of previous surveys is set forth in the field note record.

Topography within the township is based upon U. S. Geological Survey Quadrangle Four Corners, Wyoming-South Dakota (1958).

As shown hereon, the West boundary and subdivisional lines with ties to the Wyoming-South Dakota State boundary were resurveyed by Jack A. Eaves May 5, 1958 to September 9, 1958, under Special Instructions dated August 29, 1957 for Group 253, Wyoming.

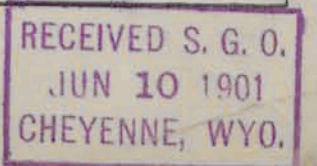

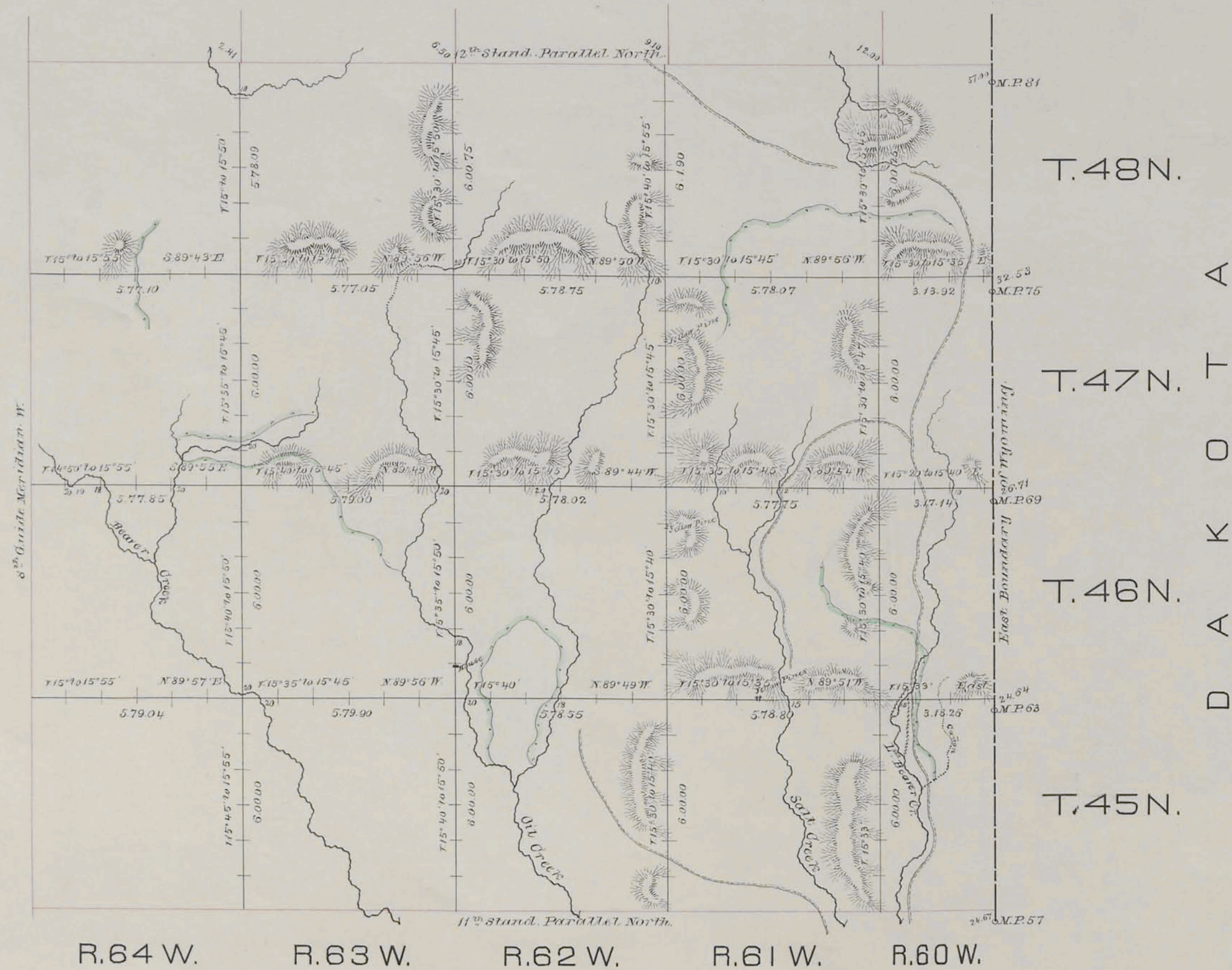
