



TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, OF THE WIND RIVER MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY, SUBDIVISION OF SECTION 5, METES AND BOUNDS SURVEY



A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines and a portion of the subdivision of section 5, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the survey of the subdivision of section 5, and the metes and bounds survey of Parcel A, section 5, T. 1 S, R. 1 W., Wind River Meridian, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plats approved December 28, 1875, and January 15, 1915.
