


TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, OF THE WIND RIVER MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.


This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines and a portion of the subdivision of section 17, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the metes and bounds survey of Parcel A, section 17, T. 2 S., R. 1 E., Wind River Meridian, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plats approved March 8, 1917 and May 18, 2004.
