



TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, OF THE WIND RIVER MERIDIAN, WYOMING.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY, SUBDIVISION OF SECTION, METES AND BOUNDS SURVEY



A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines and a portion of the subdivision of section 21, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the survey of the subdivision of section 21 and meander of the present left bank of North Fork Popo Agie River and the metes and bounds survey of Lots 5 and 6, T. 2 S., R. 1 W., Wind River Meridian, Wyoming.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved March 8, 1917.


